



Nonprofit of the Year

The ATL Airport Chamber, Inc. will present the Inaugural Nonprofit of the Year award at the Chamber's Annual Meeting on October 11, 2018. The Nonprofit of the Year award recognizes an organization's commitment to innovation which address area needs that ultimately improve the prosperity of the ATL Airport Chamber, Inc. community.

Criteria for Nonprofit of the Year include:

- Must be a 501(c)3 nonprofit agency working within the ATL Airport Chamber, Inc. community
 - ATL Airport Chamber, Inc. community - Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, Forest Park, Riverdale, College Park, East Point, Hapeville, Fairburn, Palmetto, Union City, Chattahoochee Hills and the City of South Fulton
- Must be a member of the ATL Chamber of Chamber, Inc. for one calendar year as of June 1, 2018 and dues must be current
- The organization's mission must address a need in ATL Chamber of Commerce, Inc. community and work diligently to fulfill this need in innovative ways
- Demonstrate significant results on behalf of the community
- Supports and demonstrates a collaborative spirit through creative partnerships
- The nonprofit must be governed by a volunteer Board of Directors.
- The companies of the Board Chair and Immediate Past Chair for the fiscal year are not eligible to participate

Application Process:

- Applicants must provide completed packet and application along with any additional documentation that supports submission, i.e. marketing materials, press clippings, photo, testimonials, etc. (Be thorough but concise.)
- Include a letter of reference from a client/customer

Timeline:

- June 1, 2018 Applications Due
- June 25, 2018 Finalists Announced
- August 3, 2018 ATL Chamber, Inc. Board of Directors Vote
- October 11, 2018, ATL Chamber Annual Luncheon (*Award Recipients Announced*)
